SPECIAL RULES

1. See General Livestock Rules.
2. Health: See General Rules: Livestock Health Requirements.
3. Only heifers will be shown.
4. AWARDS: The Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion will be awarded belt buckles and rosettes. Ribbons will be awarded to the top six places in each class. Cash Premiums will be given commensurate with donations received.
5. There will be two (2) classes.
 - a. Senior Yearlings: October 1, 2015 – March 31, 2016
 - b. Junior Yearlings: April 1, 2016 – September 30, 2016
6. All breeds will be shown together.
7. Bill of Sale, with heifer's date of birth and date of purchase, will be required and be presented to Superintendent at time of weigh-in.
8. Health Requirements: Out of state cattle are required to have a health certificate and prior entry permit. Papers will be checked at entry gate upon arrival. See General Rules for other requirements.
9. Fitting Regulations are as follows: Heifers may only be washed, blown and combed prior to judging and classification. Absolutely NO artificial coloring, glues or adhesives will be allowed, no exceptions, while on the SNMSF&R premises. Heifers may be subject to a white towel/glove test at any time. Violators of this rule may be disqualified from the show. No Clipping Allowed.
10. Showmanship classes (Novice, Junior and Senior) will follow the Grand Drive. Junior Market Steers and Beef Heifers will be considered for Beef Showmanship. All interested contestants need to enter on-line.
