1. BEST OF SHOW \$50.00 & Rosette

Winner of Best of Show and/or Second Best of Show will receive the cash value of their award as well as the cash value of the Best of Section, but will only receive the Best of Show/Second Best of Show rosette.

First through sixth place ribbons may be given in each class as merited by the quality of the exhibits in each class.

FLORICULTURE GENERAL RULES:

1. All products exhibited must have been grown by the exhibitor in Doña Ana, Bernalillo, Catron, Grant, Hidalgo, Luna, Otero, Socorro, Sierra, Valencia, and El Paso Counties.

2. All entries should be well-groomed and free of dirt, insects and spray residue.

3. More than one entry per class may be made by an exhibitor, provided each is a different type or color.

4. Judging will be on Wednesday morning and the decisions of the judges are final.

5. The SNM State Fair will take every precaution with the exhibits, but will not assume responsibility for loss or damage to the exhibit. Exhibits left after the pick up date will become the property of the fair after 10 days.

6. All entries must come in their own container. NO CONTAINERS WILL

BE PROVIDED.



7. The superintendents may, at their discretion, declare a new class (FLC) to aid the judges in separation of entries.
8. The Superintendent(s) may at his or her discretion replace any cash prize with a gift certificate of equal or greater value.
