Note: Baked goods and confections will be auctioned off during the Southern New Mexico State Fair Bake Sale. However, ribbons and prizes for these entries will be available for pick-up on Sunday. Persons demanding early release will forfeit any prizes or ribbons with the following exceptions:

Youth exhibitors who also exhibit livestock may pick up their entries in accordance with the following schedule upon presenting a signed Livestock Release Form.

12:00 PM - Catron, Grant, Hidalgo, Valencia, Bernalillo and Socorro Counties

1:00 PM – Sierra, Otero, El Paso, and Luna Counties

2:00 PM - Dona Ana County

Those without a signed Livestock Release Form who wish to pick up their entries early will forfeit their ribbons and cash prizes.

- 5. BEST DECORATED GARDEN CAKE AWARD \$50.00 In memory of Melinda Walker
- 6. BEST OF LOT: \$40.00 plus Rosette in each of Lots 1-10 for both Youth & Adult Entries
- 7. SECOND BEST OF LOT: \$30.00 plus Rosette in each of Lots 1-10 for both Youth & Adult Entries
- 8. MERIT AWARD: \$20.00 plus Rosette in each of Lots 1-10 for both Youth & Adult Entries
- 9. GENERAL AWARDS: No Cash Award. First through fourth place ribbons will be given in each class.

BAKED GOODS AND CONFECTIONS GENERAL RULES:

- 1. Exhibitors must live in Doña Ana, Bernalillo, Catron, Grant, Hidalgo, Luna, Otero, Sierra, Socorro, Valencia or El Paso Counties
- 2. All entries must be the <u>work of the Youth or Adult exhibitor</u> and must have been made after the close of last year's fair. Every precaution will be taken to protect exhibits, but the fair will not be responsible for loss or damage.
- 3. Any item that is entered and deemed by the Superintendent to be in bad taste will not be accepted.
- 4. All entries will be auctioned at the SNMSFR Bake Sale. For hygienic reasons, all items should be in a securely enclosed (preferably see-through) container, <u>no Styrofoam clam shells</u>. Plastic zip bags or bags with ties may be used, i.e., loaf breads, firm cookies, pastries, etc. as appropriate.
- 5. ITEMS THAT MUST BE REFRIGERATED ARE STRONGLY DISCOURAGED (fresh fruit toppings, whipped cream, 3-milk cake, etc.). They cannot be auctioned at the bake sale because of <u>unpredictable building temperatures</u>; therefore, are not eligible for a monetary or premium award. Choose frostings, chocolates, or other toppings accordingly; appearance may be affected as some may soften or melt at room temperature.
- 6. MIXES ARE DISCOURAGED. Made-from-scratch items are expected. (Exception is Lot 10, Decorated Cakes & Novelty Items, in which items are judged on appearance only.)

- 7. ENTER THE CORRECT NUMBER OF PIECES. Many entries require a certain number of items to judge uniformity. If the correct number of pieces are not submitted, the entry will not be eligible for a monetary or premium award.
- 8. JUDGING: Lots 1-9 are judged equally on (1) appearance, (2) texture/mouth feel, and (3) flavor/smell. Specific judging criteria are listed under each lot number below. Judging criteria for Lot 10 is listed under that lot number below.
- 9. All entries will be judged according to age group. The age or Division must be on the entry form. IF THE AGE IS NOT ON THE ENTRY FORM, THE ENTRY WILL BE JUDGED IN THE ADULT DIVISION.
