CRAZY HAT GENERAL RULES:

1. Exhibitors must live in Doña Ana, Bernalillo, Catron, Grant, Hidalgo, Luna, Otero, Sierra, Socorro, Valencia and El Paso Counties
 2. All entries must be the work of the exhibitor and must have been made *after* the close of 2021's fair. A purchased hat may be used as the base, but must be decorated by the exhibitor. The hat must be capable of **being worn** by the exhibitor.
 3. Voting for people's choice award will begin on Wednesday Sept. 28, 2022 and will run through Friday, September 30, 2022 during fair hours **WHEN VOLUNTEERS ARE AVAILABLE**
 4. Any item that is deemed by the Superintendent to be in bad taste, will not be displayed
 5. All entries will be judged according to age group and must be listed on the entry form.
 6. Every precaution will be taken to protect exhibits, but the fair will not be responsible for loss or damage. The owner's themselves must take the risk of exhibiting them.
