Exhibitors at the Southern New Mexico State Fair who have animals that are (or may be) eligible for the Junior Livestock sale must notify the species Superintendent by 6:00 PM on Thursday of the fair if they plan to participate in the sale and which animal(s) they intend to sell. No animal(s) may be substituted or withdrawn after being committed to the sale. If a letter of intent is not on file, it will be assumed you do not plan to participate in the SNMSF Junior Livestock Sale. Failure to appear at the sale after being accepted and included in the sale order could result in the exhibitor being banned from participating in future SNMSF livestock sales. Exhibitors are also responsible for the care of their animals before the sale and safe delivery after the sale. Sold animals will be released for proper delivery to purchaser (or packer) on Sunday of the fair, once a release form is signed by the Superintendent. Exhibitors failing to comply with this rule will not receive their sale money. **The owner must be present to sell his/her animal.** Sellers will remain at the ring until the conclusion of the Sale.
