Glued or taped hanging materials are not recommended and the exhibitor takes full responsibility for unsafe hanging materials. Be aware that items are hung on peg board. Excessively heavy items are entered at owner's discretion. SNMSF will display items as securely as they can, however the SNMSF claim no responsibility if item is damaged.

FINE ARTS & CRAFTS General Rules:

1. **ELIGIBILITY:** This show is open to any artists living in the Doña Ana, Bernalillo, Catron, Grant, Hidalgo, Luna, Otero, Sierra, Socorro, Valencia and El Paso Counties.
2. All works must be that of the exhibitor and never before exhibited at the SNMSF&R
3. Any item deemed by the Superintendents to be in bad taste will not be accepted.
4. If an item is accepted and is later determined to be in bad taste, it will be judged but will not be displayed.
5. **JUDGING:** Exhibits will be judged Tuesday of the Fair week at noon. All entries will be judged on creativity, technique, and execution. Judges are **NOT REQUIRED TO AWARD ALL PREMIUMS \OR RIBBONS**. All decisions of the Judges are final. There are no refunds of entry fees.
6. New Lots and Classes may be declared, changed or combined at the discretion of the Superintendent or Judges, to aid in the separation and judging of entries.
7. **SALES:** Any artist wishing to sell artwork during the fair will be given the opportunity to do so. **A 20% COMMISSION WILL BE CHARGED FOR SALES MADE AT THE FAIR.**
8. The Superintendent may at his or her discretion replace any cash prize with a gift certificate of equal or greater value.
9. Please be courteous to all Veteran Building volunteers. Without their donation of time, this competition would not be possible!
10. Failure to meet or follow any of the above mentioned rules will result in instant disqualification
11. **LIABILITY:** The Southern New Mexico State Fair and Rodeo holds no liability for loss or damage to any exhibits during the course of the fair. Entries not picked up one week from the end of the fair will become the property of the SNM State Fair and will be disposed of. However, attendants will be present whenever the Veteran's Building is open and due care will be shown to all entries.

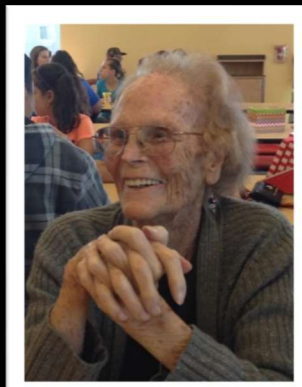
