- 5. JUDGING: Exhibits will be judged before the Fair Opens on Wednesday. All entries will be judged on creativity, technique, and execution. Judges are NOT REQUIRED TO AWARD ALL PREMIUMS\OR RIBBONS. All decisions of the Judges are final. There are no refunds of entry fees. Late entries will be accepted for display only and will not be judged or eligible for awards.

6. New Lots and Classes may be declared, changed or combined at the discretion of the Superintendent or Judges, to aid in the separation and judging of entries.

- 7. SALES: Any artist wishing to sell their entry during the fair will be given the opportunity to do so. 20% of the sale will be charged as a COMMISSION FEE FOR SALES MADE AT THE FAIR.


