CRAZY HAT GENERAL RULES:

- 1. Exhibitors must live in Doña Ana, Bernalillo, Catron, Grant, Hidalgo, Luna, Otero, Sierra, Socorro, Valencia and El Paso Counties

- 3. Voting for people's choice award will begin on the first day of the fair and will run during fair hours

- 4. Any item that is deemed by the Superintendent to be in bad taste, will not be displayed
- 5. All entries will be judged according to age group and must be listed on the entry form.
