## **Division Rules**

## See Junior Division General Livestock Rules

All **in-state** junior livestock (cattle, sheep, goats, and swine) showing at New Mexico shows must have an NMLB approved 840 tag and a Form 1 inspection issued by the NMLB before entering any county or state Fair. All **out of state** livestock must comply with New Mexico import requirements. The Form 1 inspection will be issued at the time the NMLB approved tag is placed in the animal. The application of the tag will be done by the extension agent, FFA advisor or Fair personnel. The purpose of these requirements is to keep on file a record of animals that are commingled at Fairs and shows.

### **Ownership**

Any animal shown in this department must continuously have been owned and personally cared for by the exhibitor since June 30th of the current year.

## **YQCA Certification**

All exhibitors of junior market animals are required to submit a YQCA Certificate number at entry. No junior market animal will be allowed to show without the number.

### **Entries**

The entry deadline is Friday, September 5, 2025, 10:59pm. All entries will be entered and paid online.

**Late Entry Fee:** Late entries will be accepted until September 15, 2025, with a late fee of \$25 per animal.

Entries will only be accepted on-line through the Southern New Mexico State Fair website. The entry fee is \$15 per goat. The entry fee for Showmanship class is \$5. There is no limit on the number of goats each exhibitor may enter.

- Only Wether does and Doe kids will be exhibited in the Doe goat classes.
- Does cannot have kidded and may have no more than their yearling teeth.
- It is up to the exhibitor as to whether does are slick or haired, they can be shown braced or natural while in the show ring.
- Horns tipped blunt (can exceed 2 inches)

#### Arrival

Wether does must be on grounds by 12:00 pm, September 24, 2025. Upon arrival on SNMSFR showgrounds NMLB form will be inspected by the NMLB. Animals will then proceed to the weigh station. Goats will be weighed and presented for a health check to include horns (see *classification* below for details) and diseases. Blankets must be removed for health check. If any goats do not meet inspection requirements, they may not be allowed onto the showgrounds.

#### **Show Weight**

40 pounds is the minimum weight for Junior Wether Does. There is no maximum weight.

## Pens/Stalling

Depending on the number of entries goats will be placed 2 to 3 per pen. Shavings will not be furnished by the SNMSFR.

## **Fitting**

The following materials are prohibited and include, but not limited to, painting, powdering, oiling, artificial coloring, or adhesives. **No** painting, powdering, and artificial coloring is allowed. Only water may be used on goats. Any dressing other than water will be cause for immediate removal from the show ring and face disqualification by the superintendent or judge. The showgrounds electrical grid power is limited, generators are allowed. All generators must be placed in approved areas only and equipped with G.F.I.

#### **Box Fans**

Due to the heat, and the limited power grid of the showgrounds, box fans will be allowed with the following rules.

- Fans can only be powered by generators.
- Generators can only be placed in approved areas.
- Generators should be equipped with G.F.I. outlets.
- Fans must be equipped with a ground wire
- Attaching or extending an extension cord in an unsafe manner is prohibited
- Any cords may not obstruct alleyways, pens, or are in the way for animals to reach.
- Fans must be mounted in such a manner safe for the animal.
- No fans will be permitted in aisles and walkways.
- Fans may be inspected by any show staff. Any violations will be cause for removal of fan.

## Release

Goats will remain in place until the official check-out times as provided in the schedule of events. Release/destination sheets can be picked up in the livestock office at any time and are due back by 10:30 am Saturday of Fair week.

**NOTE** – if requesting early release for goats entered in other shows (county, national, or state shows) you must have proof of entry.

#### Classes

Wether does will be shown by weight. The minimum weight for wether does is 40 pounds and there is no maximum weight. The weight at check-in will be the official weight used for classing. Whether doe classes will be placed by weight at the discretion of the superintendent.

  - o 1st 6th place in class.....Ribbons
- Grand Champion Drive
  - o Grand Champion.....Buckle, Rosette, Banner
  - o Reserve Grand Champion......Rosette, Banner

## Showmanship (Will be held with Market Goats)

A showmanship contest will be held following the Market Goat Show Grand Drive. The class is open to all Junior Market Goat and Wether Doe exhibitors and must be entered at the time your online entries are made. The fee for the Showmanship class is \$5 and is paid with online entries.

The 1<sup>st</sup> place showman of each class will receive a buckle and classes will be the following.

# PeeWee Showmanship

A PeeWee Showmanship class will be held following Senior Showmanship. The class is open to all youth who are under the **MINIMUM** eligibility to show in the market goat show as of January 1 of the current year. The fee for the PeeWee Showmanship class is \$5 and is entered and paid at the time online entries are made. 1<sup>st</sup> place PeeWee Showman will receive a buckle.
